Ambulatory Surgical Center Quality Reporting (ASCQR) Program News Blast

Have you ever had the feeling you are forgetting something important, but you can't put your finger on it? We're here to help you get rid of that feeling and remember important tips for successful quality reporting!

Ensure You Have Access for Data Submission

- Log in to the [Hospital Quality Reporting \(HQR\)](#) system once every 60 days to maintain an active Security Official (SO) status.
- Log in to the National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN) system via [Secure Access Management Services \(SAMS\)](#) once every 60 days to maintain an active account.
- Add additional **SOs** in the HQR system and **Users** in NHSN system to prevent the loss of access due to staff turnover.
- Confirm you have signed up with a CMS-approved vendor for **mandatory** collection and submission of the Outpatient and Ambulatory Surgery Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (OAS CAHPS) survey data for calendar year (CY) 2025. Remember to Submit Data on Time

- Submit COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage Among Healthcare Personnel measure data via the NHSN system. The Quarter (**Q1 2025 (January 1-March 31)**) data are due **by August 15, 2025**.
- Submit **mandatory** OAS CAHPS measure data via the [OAS CAHPS](#) website by a CMS-approved vendor. The **Q1 2025 (January 1-March 31)** data are due **by July 9, 2025**.
